

Get Flood Ready!

Notes for Teachers



These questions are designed to prompt discussion during or after playing the game with children and can lead to other activities around flood awareness and preparation.

Because Get Flood Ready! is a game of chance, some of the game squares or stories might be repeated. This can be an opportunity to ask different children their thoughts and ideas.

- How does flooding affect people? (Think about different descriptive words you could use.)
- How does flooding affect places?
- How do you think it feels to experience flooding?
- What would be the things you would be upset to lose in a flood?
- What would you make sure you took with you if your home was likely to be flooded?
- What problems might you face in recovering from a flood?
- Can you ever fully recover from flooding?
- What can we do to be better prepared for flooding in the future – at home, at school and in our community?
- What more information would you like to have about flooding? What more do you want to find out?
- Why and how do you think children should be involved in planning for flooding?
