- You are a young person from low income backgrounds (i.e. a household income of £42,875 or less)
- You are a young person from lower socio-economic groups or from neighbourhoods where higher education participation is low (i.e. POLAR quintiles 1; type your postcode in here to check: <http://www.hefce.ac.uk/postcode/>).
- You are a young person from a minority ethnic group.
- You are a disabled young person.
- You are a young person with mental health problems, Specific Learning Difficulties and/or who is on the autism spectrum.
- You are a care leaver or a young person in care.
- You are a young person with caring responsibilities.
- You are a young person estranged from your family.
- You are a young person from the gypsy and Traveller communities.
- You are a refugee or an asylum seeker.
- You are a child from a military family.
- You are a young person who is first in their family to attend higher education.
- You are young person who qualified for pupil premium or free school meals.
