If you are arriving via Manchester Airport, there is a direct train from the airport to Lancaster every hour.

The campus is a short taxi ride from Lancaster train station. If you use a taxi I recommend you not to let the taxi go until you are at your accommodation as the accommodation is a long walk (10min) from the CETAD building where you collect your room key.

If you prefer to use the bus, I recommend picking it up at the bus stop opposite the railway station. When you get off the train, follow the sign for Taxi services. Once out, you will see a bus stop across the road. You can take either the **3A or X4** bus service, which runs every 30min (Mon to Sat daytimes; hourly on Sunday afternoons and evenings).

**Checking In And Collecting Your Room Key for on campus B&B**

Guest room reception is located in the CETAD Building no 13 on the Campus Map.

To reach CETAD by car, turn into the main University entrance at the traffic lights. Take the first left exit at the roundabout at the top of the main drive, then the first right which is Bowland Avenue South. Follow this road around to the left and the CETAD building is straight in front of you. Post code LA1 4YW.

Rooms are available from 2.00pm on the day of arrival. Checkout is at 10.00am on the day of departure. On the day of departure rooms keys can be dropped off at the Porter's Lodge in Barker House Farm or at the CETAD building. There is a luggage room in the CETAD building if you wish to use it.

### Accommodation

Your accommodation is in Braystones Tarn, on the Alexandra Park Campus, close to Barker House Farm no 65 on the campus map. A detailed map of Alexandra Park is attached (Accommodation map) and Braystones Tarn is no 55.

There is a porter on duty 24 hours per day, if you have any difficulty locating your accommodation he/she will be able to help you. Telephone +44(0)1524 592304.

Breakfast is served in Barker House Farm between 8.00am and 9.00am.
