

London Published the 1st June 1798 by Rob. Wilkinson, No. 25 Cannahill



Tortola is about 25 Miles in Length along the coastline, or the Above but in a straight
line is over 40 Miles - its Breadth part about 3 Miles and contains 12,000 Acres.
Cape Mountain is 3,530 Feet high.
Fort Charlotte Mountain is 3,625 Feet high.
