LUMS will once again be hosting a Research Conference this year to bring together researchers from different disciplines within the School and to showcase our research. Doctoral researchers, as an important part of our community, will once again be invited to participate and, in particular to take part in the Doctoral Poster Competition. You will have an opportunity to present your work and to receive feedback from academics within the School and from the competition judges.

Who can enter: Doctoral researchers at all stages of their studies are invited to present a poster. There will be multiple prizes awarded at the end of the conference. Winners will be asked to briefly present their work to a plenary session of the main conference.

How to enter: a 500-word abstract should be submitted to Igor Goncharov (i.goncharov@lancaster.ac.uk) and Matthew Watson (m.watson@lancaster.ac.uk) as an email attachment by **Wednesday, 27th March**. You will be notified as to whether your poster proposal has been accepted for the conference by **Friday, 5th April**. Upon acceptance, final posters should be submitted to Matthew Watson (m.watson@lancaster.ac.uk) for printing and displaying during the conference (in the LUMS Hub area), by **Wednesday, 1st May**. Each doctoral researcher can submit only one poster. Posters must be submitted in PDF format, high resolution, and suitable for being printed at A1 size (portrait or landscape orientation).

Presenting your poster: you should be available during the conference to discuss your poster at 10:30am-11:00am and 12:30pm-1:30pm on **Thursday, 9th May**. You should also be available to attend the prize giving presentation session between 4:30pm and 4:45pm on the same day. You are also invited to attend the main conference sessions which will follow this period each day.
