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Target Course: SCC120

- ▶ High maths content
- ▶ Cohort with minimal maths qualifications
- ▶ Very large cohort (240 students)
- ▶ Core module
- ▶ Part 1 course

Recruitment

- ▶ By email (22/1/19)
- ▶ Announcement in scc120 lecture
- ▶ Earliest responses within 24 hours – both leaders and class members
- ▶ Initially 18 leaders and 20 class members
- ▶ Training (5/2/19)
- ▶ In future PASS room

First Meetings (6-8th Feb 2019)

- ▶ In regular scheduled workshops
- ▶ 2-4 students per workshop (depending on class members signed up)
- ▶ Successes
 - ▶ 40 class members signed up afterwards
 - ▶ Easy meeting, exchange of details not through me
 - ▶ Good default location to return to if necessary
 - ▶ Class members knew others in their group
 - ▶ One pair of leaders recruited the whole class!
- ▶ Failures
 - ▶ Some leaders merely left a piece of paper with an email address
 - ▶ Attendance wasn't as high as interest

Ongoing problems

- ▶ Low turnout
- ▶ Leader requests for contact/reminders to students
 - ▶ No one actually returned to workshop (I did suggest it)
 - ▶ Leaders a bit unclear on exchanging details themselves
- ▶ A few class member requests for a session time
