

Poster Guidelines for CADS 2026



Thank you for contributing to the poster session at CADS 2026! The poster session is scheduled for **Tuesday 23rd June** for the first half of the wine reception (i.e., **17.30 to 18.15**). Presenters are asked to stand by their posters for as much of this time as possible, although you are of course warmly invited to help yourself to drinks and canapés during this time!

Poster guidelines:

The following guidelines should be followed for posters at the conference.

Size and orientation:

- We recommend that you print your poster in **A0** size (841mm x 1189mm).
- Posters **must** be **portrait**.
- There will **not** be a digital display – please bring a printed version of your poster for display.
- We cannot ensure that any printing services will be available for hire on campus. So, we advise that you have your poster **printed in advance** of travelling.

Formatting recommendations:

It is advised that you only use one or two fonts and that you choose fonts that are easy to read.

Some suggestions for font sizes (based on A0 size) are:

- Poster title: 85-120 points
- Author name(s) and affiliation(s): 60-70 points
- Main headings: 50-70 points
- Subheadings: 40-50 points
- Body text: 28-36 points
- Figure captions: 18-24 points

Displaying your poster:

Posters must be printed, by you, ahead of the conference.

Upon your arrival on the first day of the conference, we ask that you promptly give your poster to the organisers at the reception desk. The organisers will put your poster up, ensuring that it is ready for the poster session later that day.
