
Fascinating Brassicas

Domestication and cultivation of *Brassica oleracea* has led to a big variety of crops. Broccoli, Brussel sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, kale, romanesco, kohlrabi and rapeseed among others are the same species but different varieties.



Origin

Their origin is unknown, but the closest wild relative is found in the Eastern Mediterranean region.
